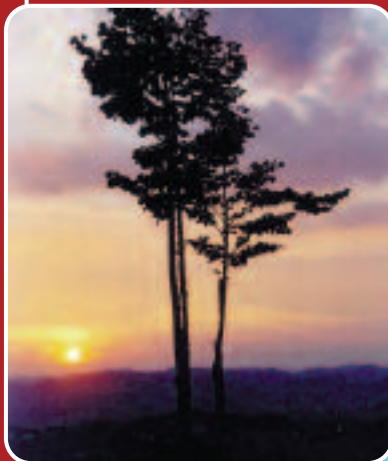

Camping Peticara can be reached via a number of routes; below we have described the one we feel is easiest.

Camping Peticara

One impressive sight is the cliff that forms the backdrop to the picturesque village of Peticara. You can reach the village on foot to make your daily purchases in the local shops. The altitude (630 metres) means that mosquitoes are conspicuous only by their absence, and there is always a slight breeze, which is pleasant in sun-baked Italy.

The surrounding area comprises a sparsely populated area of countryside with many fields, woods, mountains and beautiful landscapes. On arrival at the campsite, you will be given some information about what is on offer in the surrounding villages and towns.

Follow the autostrada from Milan to Bologna (A1). After Bologna, take the autostrada towards Ancona (A14). 110 km after Bologna, take the Rimini - Sud exit. At the end of the sliproad, turn right, towards Rimini / San Leo (if you turn left you will end up in San Marino). After 800 metres, at the first traffic light, turn left towards Ravenna / Bologna. This puts you on the Ring around Rimini. After 1.7 km, take the exit for Rimini Centre / San Leo / Sansepolcro (SS 258). Go left under the viaduct (three quarters of the way round the roundabout). You are now on the SS258, which you will take as far as Novafeltria. After 32 km you will get to Novafeltria. 400 m after the lights, turn right towards Peticara. Now the road starts to climb, at a slope of under 12%. After about 7 km you will get to the "top"; turn left at the crossroads towards Sant' Agata Feltria. After 400m, turn right for Camping Peticara.



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Camping Peticara is a beautiful campsite, situated in the Italian hills between the sea and the mountains of the Marche Region. Here you can still find peace, space, culture and nature in abundance.

Bert and Nel, a Dutch couple, discovered this unique place and have set up a jewel of a terraced campsite here. The location of the campsite provides a stunning view of the Tuscan hills and breathtaking sunsets



Three stars

The campsite covers 8 hectares and is easily accessible. It consists of 70 pitches of about 100 m² each, each with their own electricity connection (10A), water and drainage. The facilities on the campsite are excellent, so the three stars are well deserved. The campsite has a main building housing the reception and a shop. From the terrace by the spacious bar, you can enjoy a beautiful view of the hills.

Children and young people too will have a great time at the campsite, for instance in our youth house and in the swimming pool. Many young people take part in table tennis, football and water polo tournaments. Little ones can do clay modelling, drawing, cutting out and gluing during the daily craft time, run by our Dutch colleagues

Camping Peticara is a good place to come for a simple meal. In the morning there is fresh bread. In the immediate neighbourhood of the campsite, there are a number of very good and affordable restaurants. Besides pizza, the menu also lists delicious regional pasta and meat dishes. Bert and Nel will be happy to advise you.

Appartments and Maxi-Caravans

The campsite contains two appartments and a few maxi-caravans. Each 50 m² appartment (for four to six people) consists of a living room with kitchen area, two bedrooms and a bathroom. The kitchen is fully equipped, including a fridge with freezer



compartment, oven, gas hob and cooker hood. In the spacious bathroom you will find a shower, washbasin and toilet. The appartments also have a private terrace (partially covered) complete with garden furniture and two sun-beds. The maxi-caravans at Camping Peticara are thoughtfully laid-out and fully equipped. Each maxi-caravan consists of a living space with fully

equipped kitchen, two bedrooms, a shower, washbasin and toilet. The kitchen has plenty of storage space, and a fridge with freezer compartment and a gas hob are provided. The maxi-caravans, too, have a covered tiled private terrace and lawn with a picnic set and two sun-beds.



Nature and Culture

The surroundings of the campsite leave our guests impressed. An oft-heard comment is "It's so quiet and peaceful". The abundance of culture and stunning nature cry out to be discovered and experienced. Due to its central location, Peticara is a good base for excursions to such places as Ravenna, Urbino, the tiny state of San Marino, Assisi and Rimini.

The neighbouring villages are certainly worth a visit.

It is a beautiful area for walks, as every hilltop conceals yet another landscape. It is quite possible to go out on a delightful stroll in the countryside without meeting a single soul. The area is a paradise for cyclists and mountain-bikers.

A day at the beach is also an option. 45 minutes will get you to the modern seaside resort of Rimini, which has something for everyone.

In Peticara, there is a unique mining museum. The sulphur mine, which continued working until 1964, contains the highest concentration of sulphur in Europe. In the Mining museum you will discover a lot about the history of Peticara and of the ex-sulphur mine in particular.



In front of the main building is our swimming pool, measuring 15 by 13 metres, with separate children's pool surrounded by a spacious sun terrace. The sanitary facilities are fantastic. You won't find the traditional row of showers, washbasins and toilets here, but rather a series of bathrooms, each complete with shower, washbasin and toilet.
